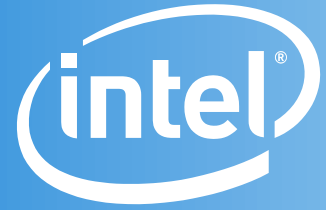

Description of Key Issue	OS
Error message “Bluetooth file transfer not complete” shown after Bluetooth OPP file transfer attempt.	Windows 10®
Bluetooth device gets Yellow Bang in Device Manager, after resuming from Hibernation or shutdown with airplane mode on.	Windows 10®
Bluetooth LE mouse connection is intermittent when PC is connected to 2.4GHz Access Point channel via WiFi at the same time	Windows 10®
Bluetooth may stop functioning in some systems after ~20 minutes in idle state.	Windows 10®
General stability improvements and optimizations.	All

Bluetooth connection between PC and Bluetooth device may fail after power off/power on cycle.	Windows 10®
